PUSH BACK!

The Fire Department celebrated the addition of a new fire engine to their fleet on Friday with a "Push-Back" Ceremony. This tradition dates back to the late 1800s when fire engines still were pulled by horses. When a new unit came to the station, the community would join the firefighters pushing it into the station where they could then hitch the horses and be ready for the next emergency. Push-back of Engine 1 (which began with a hosing off and wiping down of the new engine - another tradition as it was already clean and shiny!) was an effort of Fire Department personnel, elected officials, community members and City staff, including members of the Temple Terrace Police Department.



This new "clean cab" fire engine is designed to limit our firefighters' exposure to harmful cancer-causing gases imbedded in gear and equipment after a fire, as well as to provide enhanced fire protection and medical first response to the surrounding communities.
