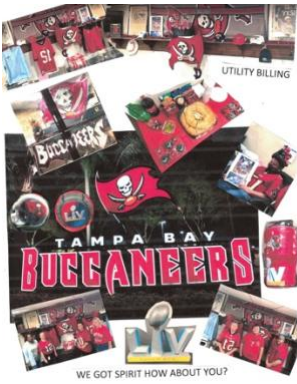

CITY STAFF KICKED OFF A SUPER WEEKEND

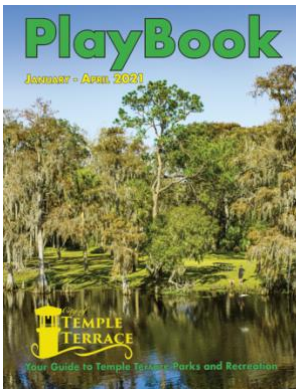
